New Business

Vice-Chairman Wobker said committees for the budget and salary needed to be set up. He stated Chairman Dycus assigned the following committees:

Jerry Bennett said the nomination forms are being mailed out October 1st. They would be due back in the office by November 15th. The directors up for re-election are Gary Guetterman, Rick Norland and Charlie Sievert. Rick and Charlie both agreed to run for re-election. The Chairman will have to verify with Gary if he wants to seek re-election.

Jerry Bennett presented Account #2393, Secretary of Transportation-landowner for relinquish of water rights. Engineering Report

Jerry Bennett said the engineers have started the leg work for the intake VFD's and copper ion generator. There was a discussion on the sludge removal from the copper ion generator.

Jerry Bennett updated the Board on the Louisburg Interconnect. The City of Louisburg has signed the agreement and engineers are working on the plans. There was a discussion on the valves and the interconnect.

Treasurer's Report

Alan Hire, treasurer, reported on CD renewals. Two CD's were renewed at 1st Option Bank. A general funds CD was renewed for twelve months at a rate of 1.10%. The second CD was renewed for twenty-four months at a rate of 1.15%,

Manager's Report

Jerry Bennett informed the Board the plant would be running free chlorine until October 22, 2016. This is an annual line maintenance procedure.

Jerry Bennett said Water #7 of Johnson County was acquiring Consolidated Rural Water District No. 6, Johnson County. RWD #6 has approximately 800 meters. Water #7 will be using water purchased from Olathe to serve the new area and there would be no effect on Rural Water District #2.

Jerry Bennett reported a fiber optic line will be crossing the 30 inch water line at Hwy 169 & 255th Street. District staff knows where the line is, but does not know how deep it is. The state widened the highway and the line is located under the shoulder in the right of way. There was a discussion on pinging the line to find the depth and also discussion on physically locating it.
