Engineering Report

Jerry Bennett reported Steve Baker with SKW was recently laid off. Scott Williamson and Danny Coltrane will be the lead engineers on the Louisburg Interconnect and Intake projects. A meeting with the electrical engineers and MicroComm will be Thursday morning at 9 am. Progress is continuing on both projects but will likely be slowing down because of the approaching holiday season.

Manager Report

For benefit of the record, manager reported the board of directors held a special meeting by email poll on Wednesday, October 25, 2016 to consider approval of a water supply contract between Miami County RWD 2 and City of Fontana, KS. The urgency for the consideration was to meet the requirement of USDA by presenting an approved contract due upon grant presentation on October 26, 2016. By consensus, the board approved the contract for a term of 40 years, contingent upon

Fontana successfully receiving a Community Development Block Grant. A connection fee of \$138,000 will facilitate a connection one half mile south of 367th & Ridgeview to supply the City of Fontana a maximum rate of 40 gpm or 30,000 gpd. The annual contracted amount is 10 million gallons. It is understood by each party the purchaser will be responsible for the installation and maintenance of the interconnection. During the poll, Mike McClurg noted a few inconsistencies within the language of the contract but, according to legal counsel, will not materially affect the document.

Jerry also reported patron nominations for board members will end November 15th and so far there are no active nominations.

Announcements and Adjournment

Chairman Dycus indicated Brad Ryckert is the new Hospitality Chairman in charge of scheduling the board and staff Christmas party. It was decided to seek a date during the week of Dec 19 and will likely be held at the Paola Country Club.
