Welcome and Approval of Minutes

Chairman Jim Dycus called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Charlie Sievert moved to dispense with reading the minutes for the regular monthly meeting. Lyle Wobker seconded the motion. Vote: 7-0, motion passed.

Mike McClurg moved to approve the minutes as corrected (remove Brad Ryckert's name-he was not in attendance). Gary Guetterman seconded the motion. Vote: 7-0, motion passed.

Manager's Report

Jerry Bennett informed the Board of a patron's concerns about the use of RF (radio frequency) meters. The patron does not want one installed on his property. He has concerns about the health issues the radio transmitters can cause. The District is currently replacing all old and high usage meters with RF meters. A RF meter had been installed on his property and asked to have it removed. There was discussion on the meters, the District's liability, and possible solutions. Jerry Bennett said he would contact the attorney to review.

Jerry Bennett reviewed District water cost, treatment cost, water sold, wholesale water cost and return on capital. There was a discussion on the cost figures and water production. The contract with the City of Fontana was discussed.
